"We have to expose these lies about Jesus, and tell everyone the truth about who Jesus really was and is ." Bracket's mine.

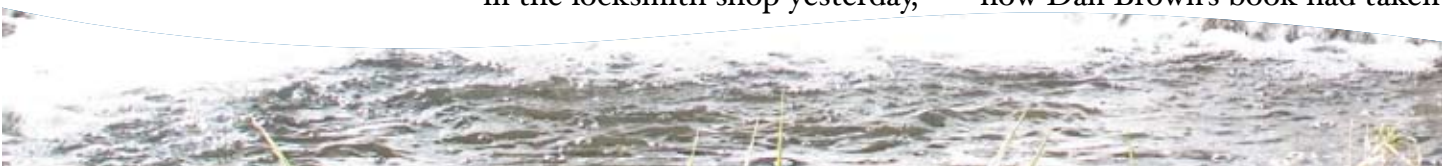

One thing about Usher's chronology however, is it does fit within the statistical confidence interval of the age of the earth, evolutionary billions of years does not. In fact, if you take different evolutionary age of the earth measurements and run a statistical analysis on them you will get a mean age of the earth of about 32 million years, with a 99% confidence interval back into time of about 232 million years. If you continually think that everything is not that old, it shows that you could not be evolving to a higher level. Instead you must question just how much am I missing with all this evolutionary dung that so smothers and cheapens my life and all society?

Think about this? Considering the current state of life in America and our short history, what would it be like if the Indian tribes had not allowed illegal immigration to this continent. But just say, for example, that only the ancestors of current Chronicles of Diversity readers would be allowed to immigrate, what would the United States of Narnia look like a few hundred years in the future? Probably not that different than Europe.

You think we have problems in the United States, just look at Europe. Even by evolutionary standards Europe north of the Alps was covered by ice during the Ice Age, some 10,000 years ago. Archeology in the rest of the world, especially in the Americas and ice age Europe, is dated similar to the fossil record circular dating methods. The cave men were found in cave men deposits, so other similar deposits with human

remains must have been inhabited by cave men, also because they were found in cave man strata.

So if no civilization truly existed in Europe 4000 years ago, all the countries, with Babel languages must have developed from the time of Abraham. In the Bible we have a recorded history to help us understand why there is so much conflict. But in Europe no such recorded history is available. The Germans are the master race, except to especially the French and to a lesser degree everyone else. Eastern Europeans hate the Russians and the Germans and have throughout history. Probably the best model is with the native tribes of North America. Their culture developed pretty much by what the land gave them to work with. If the land changed for some circumstance, they either disappeared, moved to another locale, or were assimilated into another culture.

After thirty years in Seattle I still don't understand how Seattle people make their decisions. I have learned what those decisions will be most of the time, but what they consider a logical choice, many times seems completely irrational to me. However, the people I meet who have a number of generations in what I

call the land of the tribes of the "Swept Aways." I understand perfectly where they are coming from. Swept Aways are people born and raised in that vast Columbia River Basin, in the area Seattle people call "east of the mountains." Again, I might disagree with their decision or their choice, but the concept of why they did what they did, was never among the questions. The Native American Swept Aways have a different culture than we imports, but there is still a level of communication that is shared, similar to the alliances formed with other native tribes. We are all rapidly being assimilated by creation into a Swept Away nation. This is not evolution, but really just natural diversification, a dominate concept of natural ecological science.

The greatest example of this truth however, is the difference in the red and blue counties shown in our last two presidential elections. After only about a hundred years, maybe more like fifty, there is a cultural gap between urban city slickers, and country hicks, that has nothing to do with language, nationality, or even educational levels. Formal education is pretty much standardized throughout this country, but still the inherited education from the birthing location, forms the majority of our mores, desires, and to a certain extent our aptitudes.

The only true measurable differences between America's blue and red areas, is access to water, its worldly counterpart access to capital, and the land. But urban city slickers think that it will be easier, cheaper, and more secure to export jobs to third world and developing countries, like India and China with their atheistic evolutionary religions.
